Each riding group will have no more than 6 riders per group. Riders will ride with their lesson group twice daily. Riders with be placed in groups by experience level. Please ensure when you are registering your child you select the most accurate riding level.

Riding groups will be determined, and can be altered, by camp coaching staff. Groups will be determined by rider experience and ability. These placements are made with the safety of your child, other campers and staff in highest priority.

Safety

We require a signed safety waiver for all riders/campers to be signed by their legal guardian. A copy of this waiver can be found at the end of this package. **Please sign this waiver and submit your signed copy to info@rcra.ca or bring a physical copy on the first day of camp.**

Campers aged 7 years of age are subject to an additional 15% on day camp fee due to increased counselor supervision requirements in accordance with Ontario Camps Association.

Helmets:

Proper horseback riding helmets must be worn at all times when campers are around horses. Helmets for other sporting activities, such as bike helmets, are not permitted for horseback riding. Riders who have not rented a helmet through RCRA or elect to provide their own helmet and arrive to camp with an improper helmet will not be permitted to ride due to safety regulations.

Helmets must fit and be worn with hair out of your face and long hair must be tied back into a low ponytail at the base of the neck to not obstruct the fit of the helmet. Please do not send children to camp with hairstyles or accessories that could alter the fit of a helmet.

If you would like or need to rent a proper horseback riding helmet please select helmet rental during your registration. Helmets are available for rental from RCRA for \$15/day or \$50/week.

Attire:

Campers should come prepared for riding and for the weather expected that day including rain and high sun levels. Prepare by bringing layers and sunscreen to be reapplied as needed. We also suggest bringing along a refillable water bottle to camp.

Riders should wear long pants that are comfortable to move in. If your child has riding pants or breeches they are welcome to wear them. Boots with minimal tread and a low heel, like rubber boots, are a good option for riding boots.

Weather Conditions:

Our camp day includes two forty minute rides per day, however in the event of extreme heat and/or thunderstorms one or both rides may be cancelled to ensure the safety of our campers and staff. **There will be no riding in extreme weather.**

This missed riding time will be used to participate in other camp activities such as crafts, games, and/or educational experiences about horses.

For each single ride missed, you will be credited \$10.00 towards the purchase of any RCRA lesson package.

For each double ride missed, you will be credited \$25.00 towards the purchase of any RCRA lesson package.

Before / After Camp Care

We offer extended care for campers before camp begins and after it ends. Morning extended care is available from 8:00am to 9:00am; Afternoon extended care is available from 4:00pm to 5:00pm.

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS:

I am aware and understand that activities involving horses entail many risks, dangers and hazards. Including, but not limited to the following: 1. Horses, which are powerful and potentially dangerous animals, may change their behavior at any time and may,

- without warning, jump, run wildly, buck, kick, bite or step on people or things:
- 2. Horses may collide with other horses or objects or trip, stumble or fall even if being led, ridden, or attended to;
- Negligence (which means, in general terms, a failure to exercise ordinary or proper care) of other riders or my or my child's own failure to ride safely within my or my child's ability or within designated areas and trails;
- 4. Equipment may fail;
- 5. Weather conditions can change and can sometimes be dangerous;
- The nature of the terrain can change and has certain risks associated with it including, but not limited to, exposed natural objects, trees, streams and creeks;
- The activities can sometimes be in remote areas and injuries or illness may occur and it may be a considerable distance to doctors, hospitals, or any other type of assistance; and
 Negligence on the part of A PROPERTY OWNER AND/OR THE PROVIDER OR THEIR STAFF.

8. Negligence on the part of A PROPERTY OWNER AND/OR THE PROVIDER OR THEIR STAFF. I am also aware that the risks, dangers and hazards referred to above exist throughout the trail, stable, practice and other areas and many are unmarked. I understand and acknowledge that no amount of caution, experience and instruction can eliminate all of the risks involved and I freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage and damages or loss resulting therefrom.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the Provider providing me or my child with their horses, riding instruction and other services including camp, boarding, showing, birthday parties, etc., and permitting my or my child's use of their equipment, and other facilities and the Property Owners providing me or my child with the use of their property (hereinafter collectively) referred to as "the Services"), I hereby agree as follows: 1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I or my child have or may in the future have against a
